REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals) – EC 1907/2006

REACH is a European Community Regulation on chemicals and their safe use (EC 1907/2006). It deals with the **Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical** substances. The REACH law entered into force on 1 June 2007.

The Aim of REACH is to simplify EU Chemical laws and to protect human health and the environment through the better and earlier identification of the intrinsic properties of chemical substances. REACH applies within the territory of the European Union but its impact is global.

Producers or importers of articles shall submit registration to the Agency by June 2018 for any substance contained in those articles if both the following are met

- The substance is present in those articles in quantities totalling over 1 tonne per producer or importer per year
- The substance is intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use.

In addition all producers or importers of articles must provide sufficient information, available to them, to their customers if - the article produced/placed in the EU market contains "Substances of Very High Concern" (SVHC) listed on Annex XIV above the permitted levels ($\geq 0.1\%$ w/w)

Invac is an article (component) producer and the products we supply do not release any substance under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, therefore our company has no obligation for registration nor to provide safety data sheets (SDS).

Furthermore to comply with Article 33 (1) of REACH, we declare that currently none of our Rectifier Diode and Bridge Rectifier products contain more than 0.1% by weight of any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) that are listed in ECHA's Candidate List.
