Migration GTO M2M products from European R&TTE to RED Directive

Dear valuable customer,

GTO M2M would like to inform that first products has achieved new European Radio Equipment Directive (RED) 2014/53/EU which is needed from 13th of June 2017.

As update to provided PCNs, GTO M2M need to advise that completion of all products will be delayed from end of April 2017 until about middle of May 2017 due to involved Notified Bodies are in a strong overload situation.

GTO M2M has taken actions together with the Notified Bodies to involve further Notified Bodies for GTO products to improve the situation.

Currently the following product families has already achieved new European Radio Equipment Directive (RED) 2014/53/EU: BGS2, AGS2-W, MC37i, MC52i, MC55i, BG2, BGS5, BGS1, EHS6, EHS8, PDS5, PDS6, PDS8, ELS61

For CW19/2017 expected: PHS8, PXS8, AHS2, AHS3, PH8, ALS3, PLS8, EHS5
For CW20/2017 expected: AGS2-E, AC65i, AC75i, MC75i, TC63i, TC65i, AGS3, BGS3, EES3, EGS3, EGS5, BGS2T, EHS5T, EHS6T, BGS5T, GWM 300

As noted in the PCNs customer should start already approval according new Radio Equipment Directive (RED) 2014/53/EU and assure completion until 13 June 2017 for products bringing to the market after that date.
