

ZigBee Certification

- ZigBee Compliant Platform
 - Required by ZigBee stack vendors (such as Ember)
 - Not required by product developers
- ZigBee Manufacturer Specific
 - Permits the use of ZigBee name, literature, and logos
 - Guarantees the product does not interfere with other ZigBee networks
- ZigBee Certified Product
 - Permits the use of ZigBee name, literature, and logos
 - Guarantees interoperability among products using the same public application profile
- No certification
 - Company must still join ZigBee Alliance to use the IP
 - No use of ZigBee name, literature, or logos is permitted
 - May use "Designed for ZigBee" in certain places (web site etc.)

Manufacturer Specific Certification

- ZigBee Manufacturer Specific
 - Certifies that this product does not harm other ZigBee Networks
 - Requires a product using a ZigBee Compliant Platform (stack)
 - Does NOT require use of a public application profile although of course one may be used
 - Does NOT guarantee interoperability
 - Allows use of ZigBee name, literature, and logo
- Testing can be accomplished through third-party test houses, TUV or NTS

ZigBee Compliant Certification

- ZigBee Certified Product
 - Certifies that this product is interoperable with other products running the same public application profile
 - Requires a product running a ZigBee Compliant Platform (stack) and a public Application Profile
 - Products with custom extension to a public application profile may still be certified
 - Allows use of ZigBee name, literature, and logo
- Testing can be accomplished through third-party test houses, TUV or NTS

ZigBee Membership

- Promoter (\$40,000 per annum)
 - ZigBee "Board of Directors"
 - Responsible for ratifying specifications
- Participant (\$9,500 per annum)
 - Full participation and voting rights
 - Access to work-in-progress specifications
 - Helps define all future direction of ZigBee
- Adopter (\$3,500 per annum)
 - Access to current specifications
 - May release products using ZigBee IP
 - Receive updates, access to conferences

Cost of ZigBee & certification

- Membership: \$3,500
 - Must be a member only for year you release product for commercial gain - do NOT need to renew!
 - Must be a member to release ANY product, not just certified product
- Logo Admin (only if you want to use logo)
 - \$1,000 one-off first product, \$500 subsequent product
- Testing (only if you want to certify)
 - \$2,500 for MSP testing
 - Public profile testing per device, need a quote
