

Declaration of REACH Compliance

We hereby certify that IXOLAR products meet REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and the Council of 18 December 2006. IXOLAR products mostly do not contain Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), and in products where SVHC is present, the content is less than 1000 ppm. (In accordance to REACH Article 7(2), There are exemptions, please see Note 1 below for info).

The restricted substances are published in the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), issued by European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) on 17 January 2022. (See Note 2)


IXOLAR products, under normal and reasonable conditions of use, do not intend to release of the SVHC substances, and therefore the requirement in REACH Article 7(1)(b) to register the substances contained in our standard products does not apply.

IXOLAR products also comply with the conditions of that restriction of REACH Article 69, where hazardous substances published on REACH Annex XVII on 19 November 2021.

Note 1) The sum of Lead (CAS # 7439-92-1) in our products exported to Europe is less than 1 ton per importer per year. Therefore, the requirement in REACH Article 7(2) to notify ECHA if product contains more than 1000ppm of an SVHC and tonnage exceeding 1 ton per importer per year is not applicable to Anysolar.

Note 2) The latest 223 substances subject to analysis per the REACH Regulation were last updated on January 17, 2022. Please refer to the following for the most current candidate list of substances:
