To whom it may concern: -

In response to you communication regarding Reach

Marl International Ltd. are suppliers and manufacturers of electronic components. Under the Reach regulations electronic components are classed as articles. Substances contained within articles are to be registered only if they are intended to be released under normal or foreseeable conditions of use. We do not believe any article supplied by Marl International Ltd. can be considered to release any registrable substance during these timescales.

Marl International Ltd. as a responsible supplier is fully committed to the implementation of Reach and are in ongoing contact with its suppliers for confirmation that the articles supplied to Marl International Ltd. are fully compliant with all aspects of the Reach regulations. This process is still ongoing but we do not foresee any problems with upstream compliance.


Marl International Ltd. does not expect to find in any Marl product any of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) above the specified concentrations, as defined in Article 59 (10) and Annex XIV (including all amendments).

Marl International Ltd. does not expect to find in any Marl product any of the restricted substances, as defined in Article 67 and Annex XVII (including all amendments).
