## **United States Toxic Substances Control Act Section 6(h)** (Restriction of certain substances)

In February 2021 the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published in section 6 (h) the restriction of 5 substances potentially present in Electronic Equipment. Two of these substances aren't controlled by European legislation.

### **Following substances are restricted:**

- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP) CAS 732-26-3
- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE) CAS 1163-19-5
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1)) CAS 68937-41-7
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd) CAS 87-68-3
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP) CAS 133-49-3

HARTING products don't contain substances TTBP, DecaDBE and HCBd. The distribution of PIP (3:1) is allowed until September 2024. The distribution of PCTP is allowed until January 2022.

Substance PCTP and PIP (3:1) also are not contained in HARTING products. Based on the supplier replies we don't expect to have any of the above mentioned substances in HARTING articles.
